

Campground Policies

- While we understand that some recreational drugs are now legal, we do have a diverse clientele with children and a variety of beliefs. That being the case, Peaceful Valley is a drug free zone. We appreciate your cooperation.
- All garbage and litter must be bagged and properly disposed of in the dumpster. Any glass, metal, or cardboard that can be recycled should be put in the barrels next to the dumpster.
- Pet owners must clean up after their pets immediately and place it in garbage receptacle. Pets must be leashed and are not to be left unattended to bark and disturb other campers. Only two pets per campsite. No dogs over 70 pounds.
- Campfires must be contained within the fire ring. No high fires and do not leave fires unattended at any time. Campers are not allowed to move or modify the fire rings in any way. Please do not put garbage or cigarette butts in the fire pit. Do not put your garbage in the shower house wastebasket.
- Door mats / carpets larger than 2' x 4' are not allowed on grass without permission.
- Speed limit on grounds is 10 mph starting at the driveway entrance on 348th Street. There are children and pets on the grounds.
- Electric charges are billed on the first of the month and due within 7 days.
- All regular campground policies are to be adhered to.
- You are responsible for your guests. Please have all guests register at the office.
- Your RV and the campsite must be kept neat, tidy and free of debris and clutter. Peaceful Valley will mow the grass as needed.
- Any site alterations (deck, flowerbeds, storage shed, etc.) must have prior approval from Peaceful Valley.
- A deposit of \$100.00 is required to reserve an extended stay campsite. The full monthly payment is due upon arrival. Monthly payment is due on the 1st of the month. Any partial month will be prorated in the second month payment. Deposit is non-refundable if reservation is cancelled. Payment is preferred by check or cash.
- No refund or discount for early departure.
- Hanging of laundry is not allowed. You may use a temporary laundry drying rack at the back of your unit.
- No sublet of site, change of site, change of camping vehicle or change in registration is permitted without permission of Peaceful Valley. Your site is for your family only and may not be used by friends or relatives unless you are present. Overnight guests must be cleared with the office.
- Peaceful Valley is not responsible for injuries or accidents to the camper, family or guests; for fire, theft, loss of valuables, or damages from any cause. Peaceful Valley assumes no responsibility for damage to RV for any reason. We reserve the right to remove anyone creating a disturbance or for undesirable behavior.
